

Mechanism for Review of Proposed Changes to the Core Classes in the College of Biological Sciences

All undergraduate B.S. majors within the College of Biological Sciences currently require a common core consisting of BIS2A, BIS2B, BIS2C, BIS101, BIS104 and either BIS105 or BIS102+BIS103. Any proposed changes to these classes, proposed alternative classes or proposals to drop any of these classes as required courses should be presented to CUCEP. CUCEP will take into consideration the implications of such a proposal to all CBS majors and provide one or more recommendations to the CBS Faculty Executive Committee. The departmental representatives on the FEC will gather input from the faculty in their respective departments and the FEC will either approve the proposal by majority vote or send the proposal back to CUCEP with suggestions for modifications. Once the proposal is approved by the FEC by majority vote, the proposal will be forwarded to the Dean for approval.

This mechanism for proposal review was approved by the CBS Faculty Executive Committee by a vote of 6 yes, 0 no on 1/23/2015
