



**STORER LECTURESHIP IN THE LIFE SCIENCES SPEAKER

Established in 1971, the Storer Life Sciences Lectureship is a prestigious award made available through a gift from Professor Tracy and Dr. Ruth Storer. This gift makes it possible to invite distinguished biological scientists who have established an exemplary body of work over their career to the Davis campus to present a formal lecture representing their body of work and meet with faculty members and graduate students in fields of common interest. The format for these presentations is an afternoon lecture, presented to the campus-wide community of biologists, followed by a social hour and dinner with faculty members and students whose work and interests are closely related to that of the speaker. The content of the lecture is expected to focus on the individual's own work and should seek, by example of that work, to represent the kinds of research issues that occupy the leaders in this field. Past lectures have included Nobel laureates, members of the National Academy of Science and acclaimed authors in the life sciences and medicine. The Storer Endowment provides all expenses and a \$2,000 honorarium.
